

MINUTES  
9-14-05

The Cedar Creek Board of Trustees met at 7:00 p.m., on September 14, 2005, at the Village Hall, for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing to hear comments of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget and adopting a budget for fiscal year 2005-2006. Advance notice of the Public Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in three public places in the village.

The public hearing was called to order by Chair Bode at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present.

Chair Bode called for comments from the public in regard to the proposed budget. A. Steppat recommended the board save money by canceling the interlocal agreement with Cass County for law enforcement coverage. Chair Bode responded, a one year notice is required to cancel the agreement. The board discussed the 2005-2006 tax rate request and future expenditures.

Motion by Ford to waive the three required readings of Ordinance 2005-04. Second by Rydl. Vote: Bode yes, Ford yes, Muntz yes, Rydl yes, Swenson yes. Motion by Muntz, second by Rydl, to adopt Ordinance 2005-04 termed as the Annual Appropriation Bill. Vote: Bode yes, Ford yes, Muntz yes, Rydl yes, Swenson yes. Ordinance 2005-04 shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

Motion by Rydl, second by Swenson, to close the Budget Hearing and open the Special Hearing to request the final tax request be set at a different amount than the prior year tax request. All ayes. Time 7:15 p.m.

Chair Bode called the Special Hearing to order at 7:15 p.m. All board members were present. Advance notice of the Special Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in three public places in the village.

Resolution #509, introduced by Ford, second by Muntz, approving the 2 ½% restricted funds base increase and to exceed the budget by an additional 1% increase. Vote: Bode yes, Ford yes, Muntz yes, Rydl yes, Swenson yes.

Motion by Rydl to adjourn. Second by Muntz. All ayes. Time 7:24 p.m.
