

CEDAR CREEK MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 1, 2005

The Cedar Creek Board of Trustees met in regular session on November 1, 2005, at 7:00 p.m., at the Village Hall. Board members present: Bode, Ford, Swenson. Absent: Muntz and Rydl. Advance notice of the meeting was given by posting in three public places in the village and by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal.

Motion by Swenson, second by Ford, to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2005 regular meeting of the Board of Trustees. All ayes.

**POLICE REPORT:**

The Cass County Sheriff's Department reported 89.93 hours of patrol were logged for Cedar Creek during the month of October. There were ten calls for service: Parking/24 Hours, Hazards/Obstructions, Four Vehicle Inspections, Animal/Wildlife, Theft from Building, Forgery/Check Personal, Assist Rescue Unit. Three citations were issued for speeding. Discussion was held on the speed limit between the corporate limits east to 114<sup>th</sup> Street. The State Department of Roads will be contacted and requested to install a speed limit sign in the referred to area.

**CORRESPONDENCE:**

Received and reviewed the 2005 Cass County tax rate as approved by the Cass County Board of Equalization and submitted by the Cass County Clerk.

**REPORTS OF OFFICERS, BOARDS, AND COMMITTEES:**

A report was given on the Haunted Hollow, held on October 29<sup>th</sup> at the Village Park. G. Bode reported on various activities and attendance. The event was organized and run by volunteers from the community. Bode reported over \$2000 was taken in, expenses will be taken out and a report will be given at the December meeting. A discussion was held on proper allotment of the money from the event. Bob Ford requested a list of the volunteers and pictures of the event for posting on the village web site. Bode also reported, an additional electrical supply was installed at the park and a new lock was installed on the cable shed.

**MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:**

The board discussed items to be included on a community survey. The Southeast Nebraska Development District will be requested to assist with the survey. Table to December.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Motion by Ford, second by Swenson, to approve the proposed 30' x 50' Beer Garden at Earnie's. All ayes.

After discussion of drainage problems at the Village Park, the board requested contacting the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District for recommendations and assistance. Item tabled.

Purchase of a sander tabled to December.

Trustee B. Ford reported on the possibility of having Cedar Creek declared a Quiet Zone by the railroad. Due to a possible cost of between \$400,000 and \$600,000, application will not be made.

In other business: A. Steppat again requested the board contact the Nebraska Attorney General for his opinion on ATV's being driven on Cedar Creek public streets or contact Senator Weherbein; J. Richards questioned why Cedar Creek was paying for law enforcement. Attorney Reinsch explained, the contract started in 1996 when the village received a \$75,000 three year grant from the Department of Justice. After the initial three year period, the Interlocal Agreement with the Cass County Sheriff's Department continued with less coverage. A one year notice is required to cancel the agreement.

There being no further business to come before the Board, motion by Ford to adjourn. Second by Swenson. All ayes.
