JEO/NDOR Drainage Project. Dan Fricke, JEO, explained to the Board required applications and costs of the project and provided new information on Rural Water District findings, BNSF requirements, and LPSNRD cost share. A lengthy discussion was held between board members and D. Fricke. Motion by McAllister, second by Pearrow, to hold a Special Meeting to allow all Board members to vote on the project. All ayes. Discussion was held on date and time of meeting and publishing requirements. The Special Meeting will be held 3-18-12 at 12:00 noon, at Village Hall. Notice will be published and posted. Purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the Drainage Project.

Riverbank Stabilization Project. According to D. Fricke of JEO, the project is ongoing. A total cost amount should be available by the end of March. Table to April.
