I CERTIFY THAT I HAVE RECEIVED AND UNDERSTAND THE HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT.

Permits are to be renewed on an annual basis. Valid from January thru December. Affix the permit number to the front left side of the cart (drivers side.)

ORDINANCE #2006-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDAR CREEK, NEBRASKA, TO AMEND CHAPTER III OF THE VILLAGE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDAR CREEK, BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT DEFINED GOLF CARTS TO OPERATE ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDAR CREEK, NEBRASKA, PURSUANT TO CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS; TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF ANY SECTION, CLAUSE, PROVISION OR PORTION FOUND UNCONSTITUTIONAL OR INVALID; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUBLISHED OR POSTED IN PAMPHLET FORM AND SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL, AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND AS PROVIDED HEREIN; AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME AND BE MADE A PART OF THE VILLAGE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDAR CREEK, CASS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND THE SECTIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE RENUMBERED TO ACCOMPLISH SUCH INTENTION.

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. 60-678 provides that a governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska may, in its respective jurisdiction, enact regulations permitting, prohibiting, and controlling the use of motor vehicles, mini-bikes, motorcycles, ATVs, and off-road recreation vehicles of any and all types, other powered vehicles, and vehicles which are not self-propelled, and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, is a governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska, and, the Chair and Board of Trustees thereof is its governing body, and,

WHEREAS, the Chair and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, do desire to enact regulations permitting and controlling the operation of golf carts upon the public streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, which are not defined by Neb. Rev. Stat. 60-301(16)(f) as motor vehicles, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, to prohibit the use of all off-road designed vehicles upon the public streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, EXCEPT:

1. In parades which have been authorized by the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, or,
2. As permitted by the terms and conditions of this ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, the Chair and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, do desire to permit the operation upon the public streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, of golf carts subject to terms and conditions as set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CEDAR CREEK, CASS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, as follows:

Section 1. That the findings here and above should be, and they are hereby made a part of this Ordinance, as fully as if set out at length herein.

Section 2. That any person desiring to operate a golf cart as defined in Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 60-6,355 upon the public streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, other than in parades which has been authorized by the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, as herein indicated, shall first apply for a permit upon application forms furnished by the Clerk of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, and receive from the Clerk of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, a permit for said operation of said golf cart, the requirements and criteria for obtaining said permit to be as follows:

A. Golf cart requirements.

1. Sixty (60) inches or less in width;
2. Dry weight of nine hundred (900) pounds or less;
3. Travels on three (3) or four (4) low pressure tires;
4. Has a seat for the operator; Has a seat for a passenger if so designed by the original manufacturer;
5. Has handle bars or other steering assembly for steering control;
6. **Is equipped with a bicycle safety flag that extends not less than five (5) feet above the ground, attached to the rear of such vehicle; the bicycle safety flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty (30) square inches and shall be day glow in color;**
7. **Is equipped with a slow moving vehicle emblem on the rear of the vehicle;**
8. Has a brake system maintained in good operating condition;
9. Has an adequate muffler system in good working condition;
10. **Has affixed to the vehicle a Village Permit** pursuant to Village rules and regulations.

B. Applicant's requirements.

1. Applicant must be eighteen (18) years of age or older and an owner of property within the corporate limits of Cedar Creek or within its one mile jurisdiction;
2. Applicant's license to operate a motor vehicle is not currently suspended or revoked by the laws of the State of Nebraska for loss of points or driving under the influence of alcohol or other similar driving offenses, causing a revocation or suspension of said person's operators license;
3. That Applicant must submit a proof of financial responsibility evidencing Applicant's ability to respond in damages for liability, on account of accidents occurring subsequent to the effective date of such proof, arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of said golf cart, in the amount of not less than Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars because of bodily injury do to death of one person in any one accident, and subject to such limit for one person and to a limit of not less than Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars because of bodily injury do to death of two or more persons in any one accident and to a limit of not less than Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars because of injury to or destruction of property of others in any one accident;
4. That Applicant acknowledges that Applicant shall abide by the terms and conditions of this Ordinance;
5. That a non-refundable annual application fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars shall accompany each application. Further, Applicant shall pay all other expenses and costs associated with Applicant's application.

Section 3. Upon satisfaction of the above conditions the Clerk may issue a permit for such person to operate the golf cart on the streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, under the following rules and regulations:

- A. That said permit is valid for the calendar year in which it is issued, January thru December, subject to impoundment and/or revocation as set forth in Section 5 hereof;
- B. That Applicant and/or Operator shall operate such golf cart subject to the following:
 1. **All rules of the road of the State of Nebraska** as found in Chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Nebraska, not in conflict herewith;
 2. All Ordinances of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, as found in the Village Ordinances of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, not in conflict herewith;
 3. **Operator shall possess a valid Class O Operator's License or a valid Provisional Operator's Permit;**

4. That said golf cart **shall not be operated** within the corporate limits of said Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, **between sunset and sunup** of the subsequent day;
5. That said golf cart **shall not be operated at a speed in excess of Ten (10) miles per hour;**
6. The maximum occupancy of a golf cart shall be one person per seat or as recommended by the manufacturer. All passengers must remain seated while the cart is in operation.
7. Maintain at all times the proof of financial responsibility as required by Section 2 B 3 hereof;
8. All golf cart requirements as stated in Section 2 A shall apply.

Section 4. That by Applicant signing an application for a permit to operate a golf cart upon the public streets of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, pursuant to this Ordinance, said Applicant consents to the release of all information deemed relevant by the Clerk of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, in determining whether or not to issue a permit to said Applicant based upon said Applicant's application.

Section 5. That the Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, and its Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to implement this Ordinance.

Section 6. That should a permit be issued, pursuant to this Ordinance, said permit is subject to immediate impoundment for any violation of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance and revocation by the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, after a public hearing thereon, due notice having been given to the permit holder. All law enforcement officers having arrest jurisdiction within the corporate limits of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, are hereby authorized to enforce the terms and conditions of this Ordinance. In addition thereto, any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalty provision of Section 7 hereof.

Section 7. That in addition to Section 6 hereof, that any person who shall violate or refuse to comply with the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. A new violation shall be deemed to have been committed every twenty-four (24) hours of such failure to comply.

Section 8. That should any section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Ordinance hereby adopted, is declared for any reason to be invalid, it is the intent of the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, that it would have passed all other portions of this Ordinance independent of the elimination here from of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

Section 9. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication of this Ordinance, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 10. That this Ordinance shall be published within the first fifteen (15) days after its passage and approval wither in pamphlet form or by posting in three (3) public places within the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, and shall be effective on the fifteenth (15th) day from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided herein.

Section 11. That it is the intention of the Chair and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Village Ordinances of the Village of Cedar Creek, Cass County, Nebraska, and the Sections of the Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
